

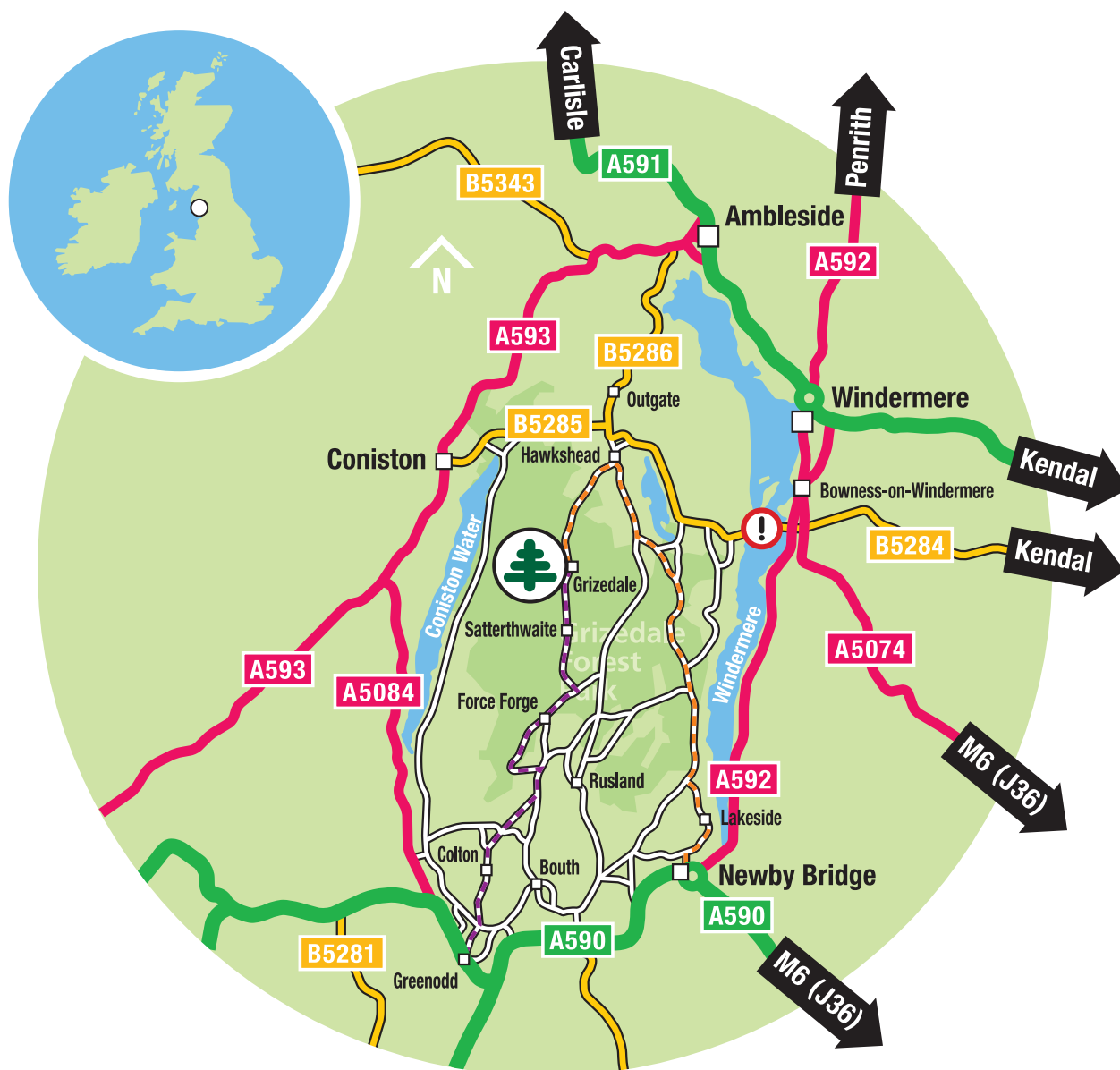
Directions to Grizedale Forest, The Lake District

From the North: A591 to Ambleside, leave Ambleside on A593 (to Coniston/Langdale), at Clappersgate turn left on to the B5286 to Hawkshead. At Hawkshead follow brown tourist signs to Grizedale, turning right at T-junction and right again as you are leaving the village (you will pass a school and coal merchants on your right, take next right after coal yard). Follow this road for 2 miles up the hill then down the valley to Grizedale.

From the South: Take junction 36 off M6 on to A590 (to Kendal). Take first left along A590 towards Barrow. At Newby Bridge turn right over the bridge (Swan Hotel in front of you). Follow this road to Hawkshead (approx 20 mins). Look out for the Youth Hostel which is on your left about 1 mile before reaching Hawkshead village. Approximately half mile after the Youth Hostel turn left up a hill (if you pass a coal merchants and school you have gone too far). Follow this road for 2 miles up the hill then down the valley to Grizedale.

Coach Access is from the south only via A590 turning right at Greenodd and then take the next right signed Colton and Oxen Park.

Please note: For satnav purposes the Go Ape! Grid Reference is SD 335943. Both satnav and AA Route Finder will suggest taking the Windermere Ferry, we recommend you do NOT use this as it is often extremely busy and can lead to delayed start times.
